

# BUA Spring League 2011

1. We will play in all weather except lightning.
2. Games are 80 minutes long, unless one team scores 15, at which point it wins. A quick halftime occurs at the first to six points, after which the two teams switch end zones. Each team will have 3 time-outs: 1 in each half plus a floater (but no time-outs after the soft cap goes on).
3. We'll use regular UPA rules. Beginners are welcome to ask for a stoppage to explain events (like a foul or other violation) that they don't understand, especially when their team is on offense (but don't abuse the privilege on defense).
3. Because time is limited, games will be soft capped at the first horn (about 10 minutes prior to time). This means add two to the current (this may occur during the middle of a point) score of the winning team to win.
4. The second horn is the hard cap. The game ends as soon as the next point is scored (so if it goes on during a point, that point is the last one; if it goes between points the game ends immediately). Ties are allowed.
5. Default lineups will be 7-on-7, but captains may go 6-on-6 by mutual agreement. The offensive team dictates gender balance: either 4-3 or 5-2.
6. **IMPORTANT:** Boone Parks and Recreation is sensitive about their field space. No profanity, no dogs, and no littering. This is serious, we can get kicked off these fields for violating those rules!
